Code Enforcement

Open Burning - If you enjoy sitting outside around your burn pit on those cool nights, remember that an open burning permit is required. Annual permits are only \$25 (one time permit \$10). If you already have a permit, remember that the permit expires at the end of the year. If you want an open burn permit for 2023, contact the fire marshal at <u>fire marshal@hulmeville-pa.gov</u> or visit the Forms & Documents page of the borough website.
