**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HULMEVILLE, BUCKS COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
ON BOROUGH STREETS DURING SNOW EVENTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of Hulmeville Borough is vested with the duty and power to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Hulmeville Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hulmeville Borough Council has determined that parking of vehicles on Borough Streets during snow events should be prohibited in order to facilitate the movement of traffic, to allow for the safe and efficient removal of snow from the streets, and to provide access during snow events for emergency service vehicle for residents who live on Borough Streets.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Hulmeville Borough Council, and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same:

**Section I.** It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, limited liability company or entity to park any motor vehicle or to allow that motor vehicle to remain parked on any Borough Street or Road which is dedicated to the public, or on which street the Borough has the duty to maintain during a snowfall, for the period of time commencing one (1) hour after snow begins to fall and ending twelve (12) hours after snow ceases to fall.

**Section II.** Any person or entity in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution.

**Section III.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
