REMINDER: YARD WASTE DUMPING IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE IN THE BOROUGH  
Weekly yard waste collection will resume in April 2024 during normal trash and recycling pick up. Acceptable yard waste includes leaves, grass, yard cuttings, branches up to three inches (3”) in diameter and small stumps and logs under 6 feet (6’) in length. Yard waste is collected and taken to a composting facility. Diverting yard waste away from the regular waste stream allows Hulmeville to have a positive impact on the planet and our environment. 
